Molly's Revenge

On Saturday, March 10, 2018, the Pistol River Concert Association is pleased to welcome back to the Friendship Hall, the fantastic Celtic acoustic sounds of Molly's Revenge.

If you're in need of an elixir to get you moving and shake the cobwebs out after the long nights and recent rains of winter, a couple of hours with Molly's Revenge is just what the doctor ordered. Performing classic Celtic jigs, and reels with twists of Scandinavian, French and American influences tossed in, this energetic trio will have you smiling, clapping along, and maybe even dancing in the aisles before you know it. Molly's Revenge has recorded a half dozen CD's, and performed their lively traditional Celtic tunes at festivals, stages and special events in the USA, Scotland, Australia and China.



Playing the bagpipes, whistles and border pipes, David Brewer is a dynamic Celtic presence on the stage. With over 20 years experience playing these instruments, including time studying and playing in Scotland, David has become known as one of the best pipers on the west coast. In addition to his spot on musicianship he has composed dozens of traditional tunes, several of which have been tapped for use on television, recordings and indie films.

John Weed brings his own 20 years of experience to the group as a master of Irish fiddle following his classical training on the instrument. Like David, he received some great on-the-job experience while living in Ireland, playing and studying with some of the greats, as well as teaching fiddle workshops.

Guitarist and mandola player, Stuart Mason has been playing traditional tunes for over 40 years. In addition to his Celtic and bluegrass performances, he has written award winning original compositions, and has taught classes and workshops in traditional musical techniques.

Come join us at the Friendship Hall on March 10th for a fast paced night of traditional Celtic music delivered by Molly's Revenge. Doors open at 7PM and the show starts at 8PM.


