ING HEART BLUEGRASS

Well, as sometimes happens when bringing our monthly musicians into Pistol River, scheduling issues this month have us in a quick turnaround between shows. But this just means we get to hear more great music a little sooner than usual. So mark your calendars for July 14th, when we welcome Burning Heart Bluegrass to the stage at The Friendship Hall.

Burning Heart Bluegrass is a string quartet that brings all the energy, fast picking, and wonderful harmonies we all love in this music from the hill country. All the members started playing in their early years, and each brings decades of musicianship to the stage.



Mandolin specialist and vocalist Jeff Fleck got his start with a garage rock band back in the day. Always a folk fan, he gravitated toward the fast pace of

bluegrass, and its folksy roots over his career and has been playing strictly bluegrass for 15 years now. Guitarist Donn Cunningham has similar rock roots in his past, but said he was sold on bluegrass early on after seeing Clarence White of The Byrds play fiddle tunes on his guitar!

Keith Chagnon, on the other hand, took up the banjo in grade school. He played as much as he could, and spent hours listening to records by banjo bluegrass legends. Along the way he won numerous picking contests, and has had the opportunity to play in bluegrass bands from the Midwest to the Pacific Coast. And Oregon native Ron Vance rounds out this talented group, as the rapid strumming bass player. Ron's love of the genre also came a little later in life, but since diving into the music he has never looked back.

Burning Heart Bluegrass has played numerous venues, and been making regular bluegrass and folk festival appearances in California, Nevada and Arizona over the last five years. From Pistol River, the band is heading north to perform at the Darrington Bluegrass Festival in Darrington, Washington.

Please join us at 8PM on July 14th in the Friendship Hall, for two hours of harmonies, rapid string strumming, and no doubt a bit of hand clapping and foot stomping, with Burning Heart Bluegrass.
