

MARTY O'REILLY & THE OLD SOUL ORCHESTRA

We all form assumptions based on what we know of the world. For example, when you walk into the Friendship Hall on November 10th, and see the members of Marty O'Reilly & The Old Soul Orchestra on stage with a resonator guitar, violin, upright bass and drums, there are some assumptions you'll make as to the type of great music you're going to hear. The music will indeed be fantastic, but those initial expectations are likely to be tossed out the window once the band starts playing!

With musical influences that included John Lee Hooker, Tom Waits and Radio-head, Marty O'Reilly & The Old Soul Orchestra meld snippets of gypsy jazz, blues, classical violin, and even a hint of psychedelic rock from time to time into entertaining and entrancing compositions.



Front-man Marty O'Reilly plays that electric resonator guitar and is the bands vocalist. He'll be alternating between slow strums and rapid-burst-picking with the irregular musical shifts many of the arrangements take. The lyrics he writes and sings are deep and searching, and wonderfully sung in his unique haunting vibrato.

Chris Lynch is the groups violinist, who when not performing his eclectic work with this group enjoys writing film scores. He calls his playing experimental effected violin, stating "I really don't stick to fiddle traditions, but instead like to find my own textures and voice." By the end of the evening, you'll appreciate the violin as an instrument that plays the blues.

Bassist Ben Berry and drummer/percussionist Matt Goff beautifully round out this diverse foursome. Both maintain a presence in each song that demonstrates their parts as essential components of the scores, and not just background tunes or beat keepers.

Like many bands to come to Pistol River, Marty O'Reilly & The Old Soul Orchestra is tough to pin to a particular genre. But they are exceptional musicians with a flair for the unexpected in their song-writing that will certainly have the place hoppin'.

This unique performance will be a great wrap up to the year at Pistol River. So, please join us at 8PM, November 10th at the Friendship Hall for a night with Marty O'Reilly & The Old Soul Orchestra.
