

# FLAMENCO PACI

Get ready for some beautiful fast strummed guitar, toe tapping background percussion, and expressive dance that will bring a taste of Spain to the Friendship Hall on October 13. That's when Oregon based Flamenco Pacifico graces our Pistol River stage with their high energy artistic show steeped in this classic genre.

One experienced flamenco guitarist is a wonder to behold, but Flamenco Pacifico centers around two guitar specialists, each with decades of classical and flamenco work to their names.

Band founder Berto Boyd has studied, played and performed flamenco,



They recruited the expertise of Professor Terry Longshore, a noted percussion specialist with a long list of achievements in the specialty ranging from the concert stage to jazz and rock. His work has been featured on numerous CD's and motion picture soundtracks.

Also brought in was jazz bassist Randy Tico. After making a name with the group Matrix, Tico moved on to a Brazilian jazz specialty that saw him touring the world with Flora Purim and Airto. He also recently toured with Jeff Bridges.

Boyd stresses that flamenco is an art form beyond just the music. As such, he has incorporated dancers as a critical part of the ensemble. Elena Villa has been a dance performer since the late 1970's and has been and instructor of flamenco and belly dancing for over 20 years. Fellow dancer Melissa Cruz has been an artist and instructor in flamenco for over 15 years, performing with numerous dance troupes, and keeping a busy teaching schedule.

Please join us at 8PM, October 13<sup>th</sup> at the Friendship Hall for a night with Flamenco Pacifico. It will be a wonderful night of musical culture and passion that, as Berto Boyd describes it, "speaks to peoples hearts."
