KATE POWER & STEVE EINHORN

Sometimes in these rainy days of winter, the heart needs a bit of pampering: Some good story-telling; a backdrop of great acoustic instrumentation. In other words, enjoying some American Folk music. You'll be able to kick back and do just that on Saturday, March 2, 2019, at the Friendship Hall, when the Folk duet Kate Power and Steve Einhorn take the stage.

Kate and Steve have been a part of the folk music scene for decades, sharing the stage along the way with some of the genre's legends, including Pete Seeger and Tom Paxton. In addition to being regulars at folk festivals across the country, they also were guests on A Prairie Home Companion a few years back, when the radio show still went by that name.



Born in Boston, Kate caught the folk bug early in life. At

fifteen, she was the opening act in coffee houses and festivals for the likes of Loudon Wainwright III, and Townes Van Zant. In addition to her multi-instrumental talents and beautiful singing voice, she has become a prolific and noted songwriter. Her song "Travis John" not only won the Music2Life grand prize at the 2006 Kerrville Folk Festival, but she also notes that it has "become an anthem for peace in the voice of one young soldier," and has been used in soundtracks, ballets, and is commonly sung at vigils and singalongs.

Steve was also a young east-coaster when he jumped into the folk scene. He was active in bluegrass and jug bands from New York to Boston before moving to Portland in the late '70s. An accomplished guitarist, Einhorn also has a smooth as silk, versatile voice that wonderfully carries tunes on its own, but also can wield wonderful harmonies that other artists regularly seek him out for. As a songwriter and performer, he beautifully meshes the music with the narrative, making the songs come alive.

Come join us at the Friendship Hall on March 2nd for a heart-warming night of Folk Americana, courtesy of the Pacific Northwest's own Kate Power and Steve Einhorn. Doors open at 7PM and the show starts at 8PM. We'll see you there!
