TRACY GRAMMER

It's hard to imagine a more pure and lovely voice than that which local music lovers will blissfully enjoy at the Friendship Hall on September 23rd when folk artist Tracy Grammer takes the stage.

Though she laughingly admits to pop interests growing up - listening weekly to Casey Kasem's Top 40 - Tracy has become a Folk Music mainstay for the past 30 years. Classically trained in violin and vocals, she broke into Folk in a big way in the mid-1990s when she hooked up with genre legend Dave Carter. The pair worked together for 6 years, becoming a top folk draw nationwide until Dave's untimely death in 2002.



Tracy then embarked on a solo career that along the way, saw her share the stage or record with the likes of Joan Baez, Odetta, and Mary Chapin Carpenter, and open for Suzanne Vega and Judy Collins. Folk Radio notes that Grammer has been one of the top 50 played artists 20 times, and her 2018 album Low Tide was that station's #9 most-played album that year. The Boston Globe calls her "One of the finest singers and musicians in folkdom." And fellow folk singer Richard Shindell notes, "Tracy Grammer has that elusive quality of being able to speak directly to another person's heart the moment she starts singing."

Flawless guitar and fiddle playing will accompany that extraordinary voice as she sings her compositions, undoubtedly a few of Daves creations, and maybe a unique cover or two for good measure when she steps onto our cozy stage! So, please join us for a beautiful night of folk music with Tracy Grammer at 7:30 Saturday night, September 23rd at the Pistol River Friendship Hall.
